Do you enjoy paddling a **kayak down calm tropical waters** and watching birds and wildlife? Or perhaps you would rather **seek out exciting whitewater** runs dropping out of the lush Maya Mountains. Come along with Conservation Adventure Tours into Belize's meandering jungle rivers, mysterious caves and the breathtaking beauty of its coral reefs and rainforests.

A Naturalist and Licensed Tour Guide will give you the opportunity to learn from and participate in the protection of these marvelous places you are adventuring in !!!

Manatee River and Lagoon: Explore a variety of ecosystems in the Gales Point Wildlife Sanctuary, from river jungles flowing into manatee lagoons. Follow the twisting mangrove creeks all the way to the beach at the Caribbean Sea. Stay in cabanas at the village of Gales Point Manatee and experience authentic Belizean culture and learn about their many rhythms, songs and dances at the Maroon Kriol Drum School, located near the tip of a thin peninsula in the beautiful Southern Lagoon. 3 nights \$300 USD

Sibun Watershed Exploration: Experience the many wild and scenic areas of central Belize by kayaking and camping along the Sibun River and its tributaries flowing from the hills and caves of the Maya Mountains. Hike to waterfalls along the scenic Hummingbird Hwy and learn about plants from a wise kriol bushdoctor. After 1 night in a cabana, enjoy 2 nights of low impact camping and wildlife watching along these scenic waterways as they wind their way toward the sea. 3 nights \$330 USD

Hike and Paddle the Cockscomb: Central America's only Jaguar Reserve, the Cockscomb Basin Wildlife Sanctuary is a great place for a hike to hidden waterfalls and enjoy some breathtaking views along the way. Spending 2 nights in cabins within the reserve, will allow us to take night walks in the jungle as well as enjoy the birdlife which is best at dusk and dawn hours. Finally, we can use kayaks to float our way back out of the reserve, navigating several class 3 rapids in the South Stann Creek Gorge. 2 nights \$275 USD

4 day Adventures in Southern Belize: Many of Belize's visitors are not fortunate enough to reach the Toledo District in the far south with its wild areas and beautiful indigenous communities. We can use kayaks to explore the Rio Grande from its bubbling source near a Maya village that is famous for it's Chocolate farms and the Archeological site of Lubantun. Heading farther south, the Moho River and its tributaries, are a great playground of caves and waterfalls. Before leaving, a visit to the coast and the Garifuna village of Barranco is a great place to experience yet another colorful culture of Belize.
